Estimating and describing the UK impact investing market

A summary of the key findings from our report

Impact investments are investments made with the intention to generate positive, measurable social and environmental impact alongside a financial return.

The size of the market


- The UK impact investment market was worth an estimated £58 billion in 2020.
- The UK market represents an estimated 3.3-8% of the total global market.

Current vs. future market players




The composition of the market

- Social investors, private equity and venture capital firms and foundations were identified as the leading impact investors in the market today.
- Institutional investors, were identified as the primary drivers of future growth.
- Healthcare, affordable and clean energy, and sustainable cities and communities are the top focus areas for investment.

Our survey of the market

- 97% held the view that over the past two years asset allocation to impact had been increasing.
- A weighted average of all respondents to current estimated impact AUM results in a potential 15% growth, which could double funds allocated to impact to over £100bn in five years.
- Approximately 90% reported that 2020 returns were either in line or exceeded their targets.

The UK impact investment market and future drivers of growth

- While the market is now sizeable, relative to mainstream investing, it is still growing from a
 comparatively small base. There is significant headroom for growth as the capital flowing to
 impact is currently estimated to be less than 1% of total UK AUM.
- As well as the size of the UK impact investment market, we also assessed investments that we
 describe as impact-aligned: investments that are generating positive social or environmental
 benefit but that are not made intentionally and are not measured. We found that in 2020 there
 was £53bn of impact-aligned investments in the UK.
- There is a large and growing green, sustainable, sustainability-linked and social bonds market in the UK. As of 2020, this was c.£7.9bn of capital raised.
- We identified key drivers for future market growth including:
 - Policy initiatives like the FCA's consultation on disclosure and labelling of investments;
 - The role that blended finance could play in catalysing more institutional investment;
 - The power of encouraging impact-aligned sectors to shift into more intentional and accountable investment approaches;
 - The continuing importance of dispelling the myth that impact investing requires sacrificing financial returns; and
 - The need for more impact investment vehicles that can take on institutional investment.
- We also outlined two key themes likely to shape the future market: a 'Just Transition' approach to
 impact investing and the growing interest in investing in nature-based solutions.
- The report concludes with observations about strengthening future market estimates, with particular attention paid to improving data flows between mainstream financial services and the impact investing community.
